Overview

Accident reporting and investigation are important for supporting a safe and productive work environment, complying with regulatory requirements, and improving organisational processes. When an accident occurs, it should be reported correctly and as soon as possible so that an appropriate investigation can be carried out.

Through proper investigation of the events leading up to an accident and the contributing factors involved, organisations can develop and implement processes, procedures, and control actions to help reduce the likelihood of similar accidents occurring again in the future.

Who is it For?

This course is suitable for personnel who may be involved in reporting, investigating, analysing, or supporting follow-up actions after workplace accidents, including:

- Supervisors and team leaders
- HSE personnel
- Managers responsible for workplace safety
- Operations personnel
- Maintenance personnel

- Personnel responsible for corrective and preventive actions following workplace accidents
