Dry Compressed Air Emergency Breathing System - Initial Deployment

The aims and objectives of the CA-EBS Initial Deployment are to ensure that the delegate gains the required knowledge and understanding of the particular hazards and properties of a Compressed Air Emergency Breathing System (CA-EBS) and appropriate practical emergency response actions to take should the requirement for emergency deployment arise.

This programme has been developed to address initial equipment introduction training requirements only and is designed to be delivered in a 'dry' training environment. This course is intended only for those already in possession of a valid T/BOSIET, T/FOET or T/HUET certificate without CA-EBS.

General Course Objectives

Upon successful completion of CA-EBS Initial Deployment, delegates will be able to explain or demonstrate:

- The fundamental differences between re-breather and compressed air systems (technology and use)
- The rationale and use of compressed air emergency breathing systems in helicopter emergency situations
- The hazards associated with compressed air emergency breathing systems
- A pre-flight inspection of the life jacket and CA-EBS
- Donning the life jacket with CA-EBS correctly, including 'buddy check'
- An emergency deployment of the CA-EBS in a dry environment

Course Content

- Fundamentals of CA-EBS, differences from other EBS devices and their advantages, disadvantages and unique hazards.
- Components and elements of the CA-EBS
- The operation of CA-EBS equipment in conjunction with other survival equipment.
- Donning of and pre-donning checks of CA-EBS life jackets
- How to deploy CA-EBS both in and out of water.
